



CAIRO UNIVERSITY

Cairo University, known as the Egyptian University from 1908 to 1940 and as King Fouad I University from 1940 to 1952) is a prominent university in Egypt . Its main campus is located on the banks of the Nile at Giza . The Egyptian University was established on December 28 , 1908 and was initially located in various locations in Cairo, but it was established in October 1929 at its current location. It is the oldest higher education institution in Egypt after Al Asr University . Originally a private institution, it became a government institution in 1925 under King Fouad I after the King's death in 1940 as King Fouad I University and after the 1952 revolution as Cairo University. Today, 155,000 students study 22 subjects here. Having produced three Nobel laureates, the university ranks among the top 50 institutions of higher education in the world with the largest number of students.
