



The Lucian Blaga University of Sibiu is a public university in Sibiu, Romania. It is named after the philosopher, poet, and playwright, Lucian Blaga. It was founded in 1990 with five schools: Letters, History and Law, Medicine, Food and Textile Processing Technology, Engineering and Sciences. Founded in 1990, the Lucian Blaga University of Sibiu is based in Sibiu, a city in Transylvania, Romania. Initially a small school, it soon became a fully-fledged university.

Lucian Blaga University of Sibiu is considered to be amongst the best Universities in Romania. According to the QS World University Rankings it is ranked amongst top 15 prominent universities. Lucian Blaga University of Sibiu has an acceptance rate of 60%–70%. The University provides grants and scholarships to the deserving candidates.
